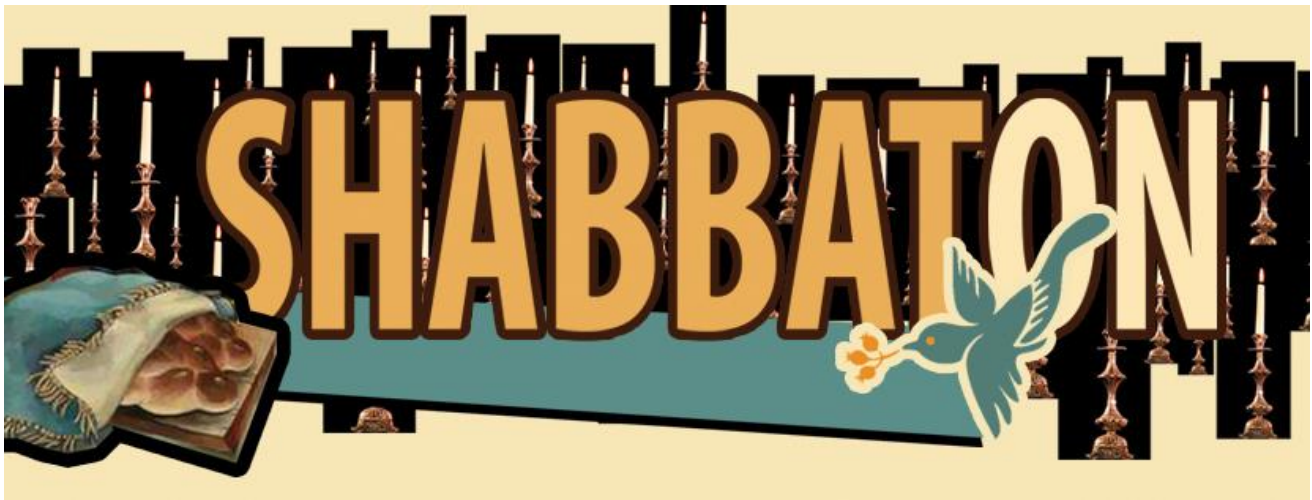

October 1 @ 10:00

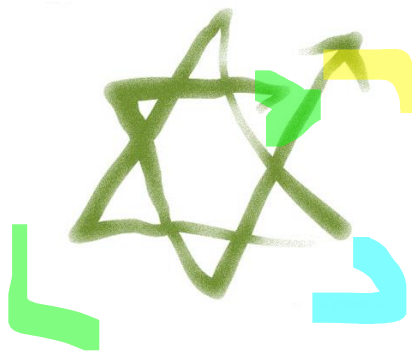
