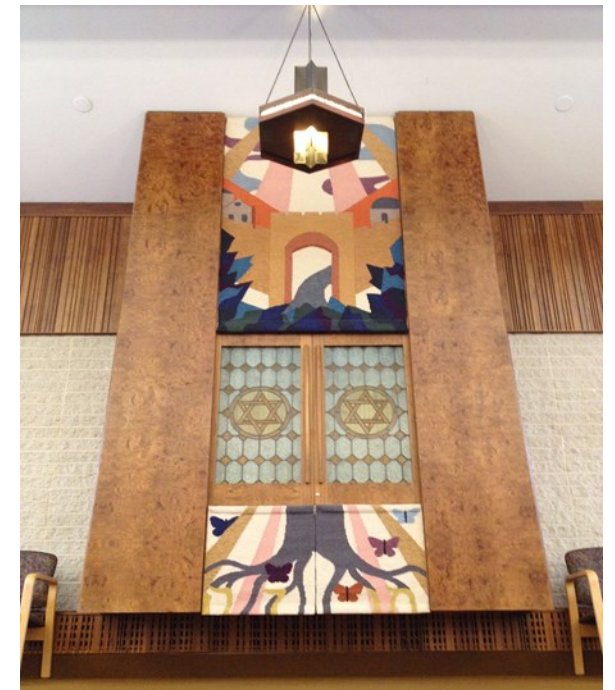

Sunday, October 22, 2pm, at Laurel School-Lyman Campus—Dr. Diane Afoumado, of the U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum, will share how to use the International Tracing Service digital collection, one of the largest Holocaust archives in the world. The archive was established by the Allied powers after World War II to help reunite separated families and to trace missing family members.
