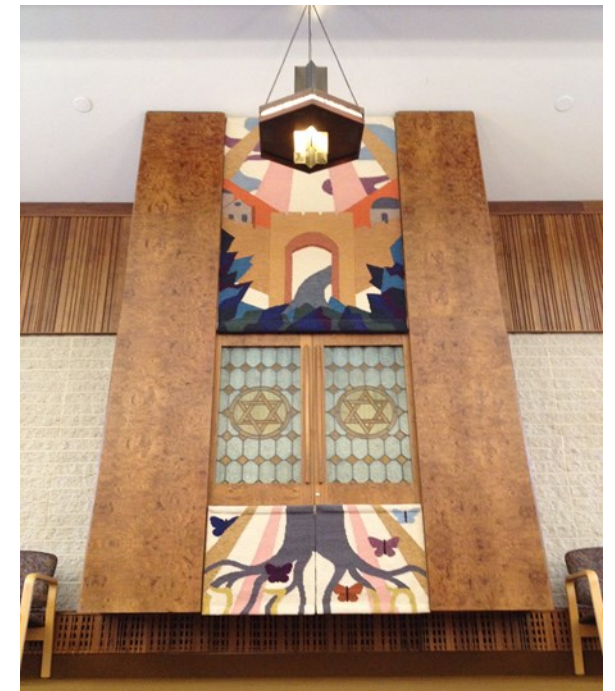

Operation Warm Up provides warm clothing, jackets, and other supplies for the city’s homeless population that is given out in January, during the annual Homeless Stand Down event, a heart-warming day-long where the homeless can get free medical care, haircuts, and pick up the supplies our community plays a large role in collecting. **This year the Jewish community has been asked to supply: pre-packaged (new) socks, adult women’s pre-packaged (new) underwear, adult men’s pre-packaged (new) underwear, winter hats, adult hoodies (XL and up), adult waterproof winter gloves.
