If you're planning to attend our Chanukah Party this afternoon, feel free to bring your own chanukiah and candles.



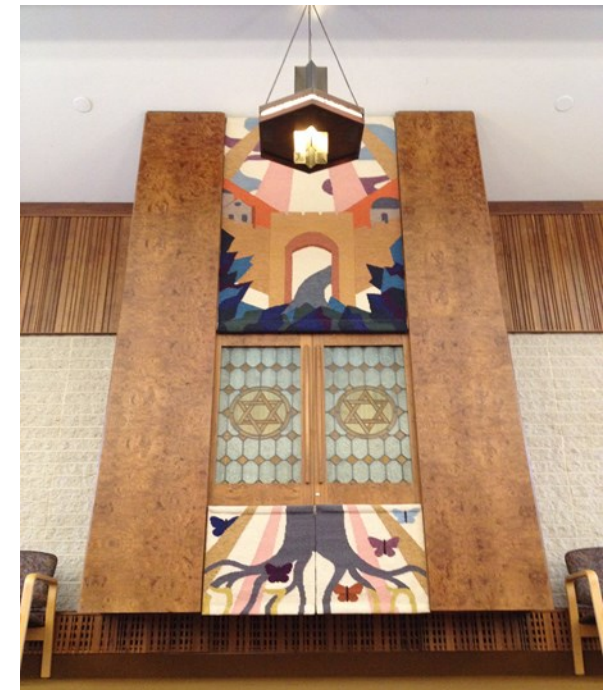
