Sunday morning, March 12

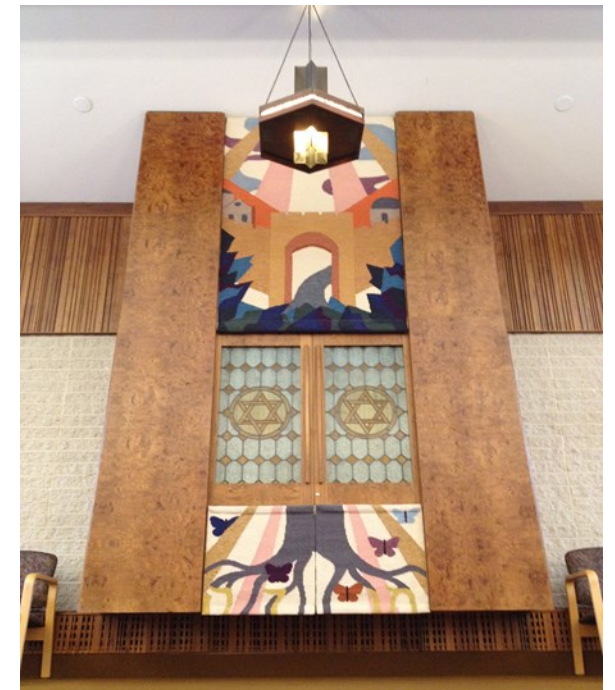
Megillah reading at 11:30am **IN PLACE OF** 9am minyan
