terrace at 6pm. Kosher food available for purchase from Kantina.

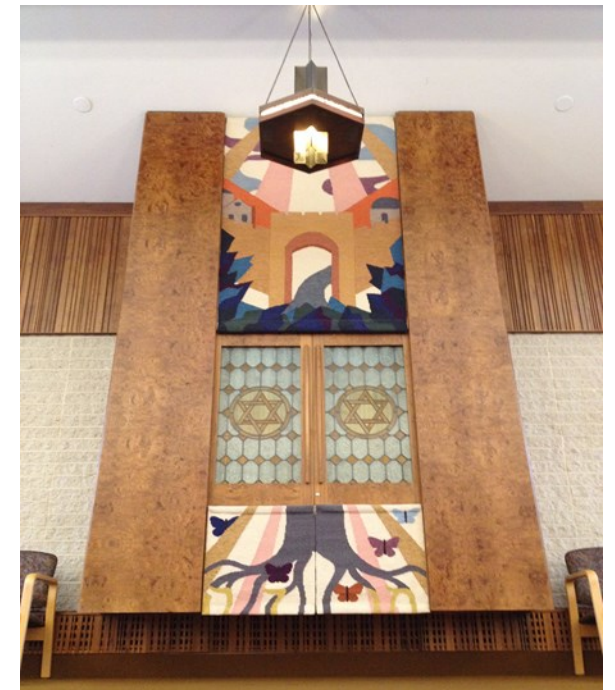
**The cleveland.shin.shinim program is looking for next year's
