For your convenience, childcare is available each Shabbat for children birth to 5.

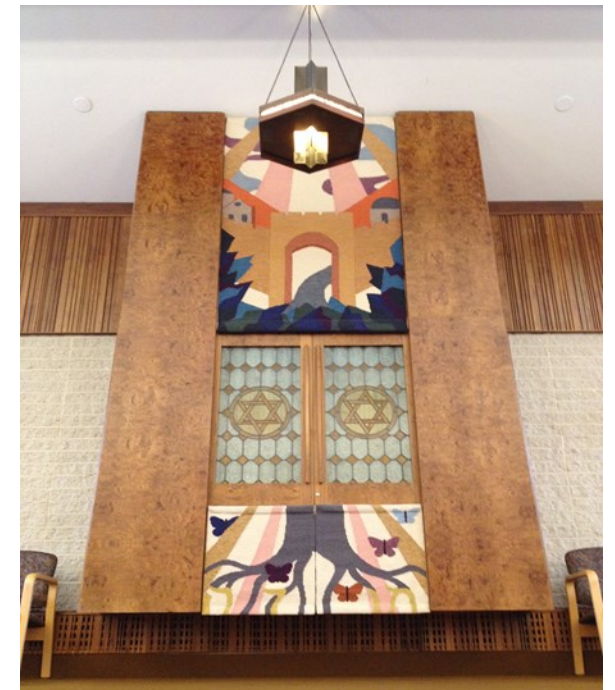
COMMUNITY EVENTS
