This training will teach you how to recognize an overdose, how to respond to an overdose and be able to administer nasal naloxone. A free narcan kit will be provided to each attendee. The Spy Behind Home Plate

Cedar Lee Theatre. opening July 19 - Aviva Kempner's *The Spy Behind Home Plate* is the first feature-length documentary to tell the real story of Morris "Moe" Berg, the enigmatic and brilliant Jewish baseball player turned spy. Berg caught and fielded in the major leagues during baseball's Golden Age in the 1920s and 1930s. But very few people know that Berg also worked for the Office of Strategic Services (OSS), spying in Europe and playing a prominent role in America's efforts to undermine the German atomic bomb program during WWII. *The Spy Behind Home Plate* reveals the life of this unknown Jewish hero through rare historical footage and photographs as well as revealing contemporary and past interviews with an All-Star roster of celebrities and other individuals from the worlds of sports, spycraft, and WWII history.
