## COMMUNITY EVENTS

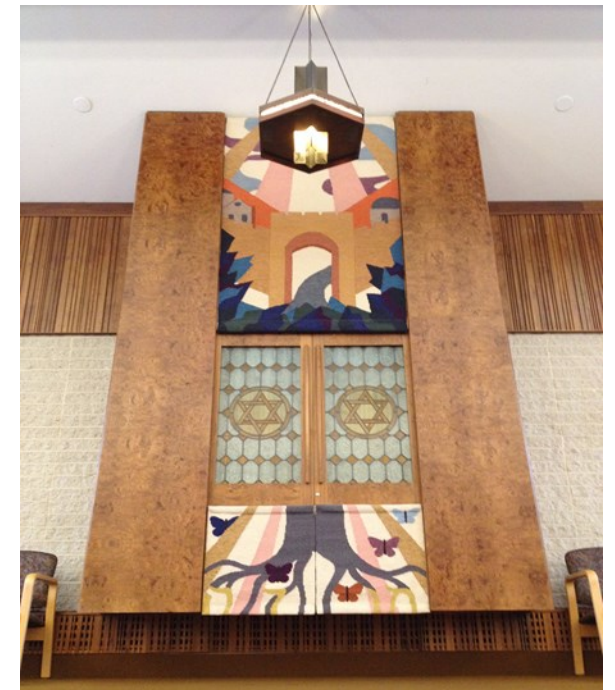
