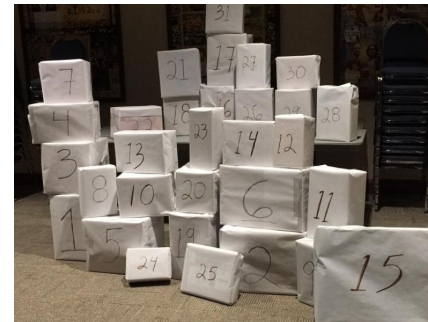
Geshher Minyan
