### WHOLE IN ONE: The WHOLE Jewish Bible in ONE Year

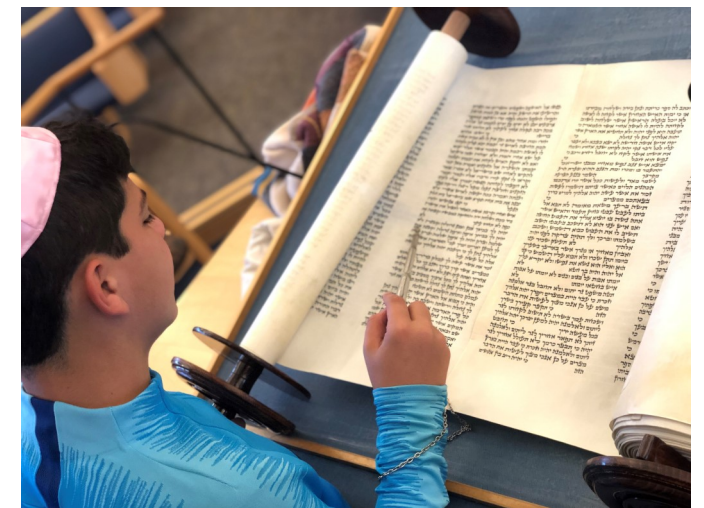
