Kol Israel 2017 Fall Memorial—Sunday, September 24, Zion Memorial Park. 2:00 pm.

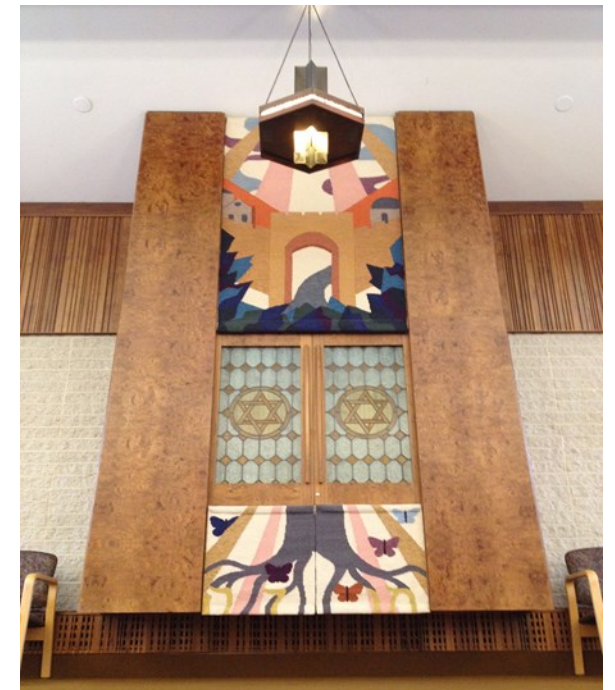
